Members of the Strive Advisory Committee represent the diversity and complexity of the Child Care and Early Years sector in our region. This committee is tasked with ensuring that strategic priorities are put into action and the multiple perspectives of its membership help guide and support organizational decision making.

The Advisory Committee is responsible for:

- Supporting Strive with the short and long-term viability and sustainability of the organization;
- Defining and communicating the purpose, vision, goals, and objectives of Strive;
- Supporting the development of, and endorsement of Strive's annual workplan and financial plans;
- Responding to community needs, providing guidance and solutions when possible;
- Establishing and sustaining partnerships with community groups and child care centres;
- Reviewing and providing feedback and recommendations on policies, procedures, service delivery, and emerging priorities and initiatives.

**Your Commitment:**

Members of the Advisory Committee are asked to serve a minimum of a 2-year term, contingent on current organizational role. Advisory Committee members commit to approximately 5 hours per month, including meetings and occasional related work. Advisory Committee meetings take place on the third Wednesday of every month from 2:00-4:00 PM and are currently delivered in a hybrid-format, with both in-person and virtual participation. There are a minimum of 10 meetings annually (No meetings in July and August) and Advisory Committee members are expected to attend a minimum of 8 of those meetings.
