

Full Time Cook

This position requires an individual to work Monday to Friday 7:30 am – 2:30 pm, is considered a full time position and includes an excellent benefits plan.

The cook position is responsible for all duties relating to providing high quality, nutritious meals in a safe and hygienic environment. The position is responsible for purchasing, preparation and serving of all snacks and meals relating to the childcare center. Some cuddle time will be required in the infant room to help fill ratios – cuddles only – all the fun and none of the messy stuff!

Roles & Responsibilities:

- Prepare and serve morning snack and lunch each day, including providing dishes and utensils to each room
- Prepare afternoon snack for the staff to serve at the appropriate time
- Maintain a clean, tidy kitchen, following proper sanitary procedures as well as personal hygiene
- Ensure that kitchen appliances are clean and in good working order
- Follow proper procedures and standards in regards to food preparation and storage set out by the London-Middlesex Health Unit
- Ensure that food allergies and dietary requirements of the children are taken into account every meal through communication with other staff members
- Grocery shopping must be completed every weekend (2.5 hours of pay included weekly)
- An organized record of previous menus and all recipes must be maintained
- Update and change the menu seasonally, communicating those changes to the director for publication to parents and staff

- Adhere to the guideline set out by the Ministry of Education
- Develops and maintains relationships with outside agencies including the London-Middlesex Health Unit, Ministry of Education, inspectors, cleaners, and suppliers

Qualifications & Education:

- 3-5 year experience working in a kitchen as the primary cook in a similar environment
- Completion of Food Handler's Certification within the last 2 years (Institutional course preferred)
- Knowledge of the Canada's Food Guide, London-Middlesex Health Unit standards required
- Knowledge of the Day Nurseries Act is an asset
- Vulnerable persons check dated within the last six months required
- Valid First Aid and CPR Certificate
- Own transportation required for weekend grocery purchases
