- As a pedagogical leader, regular and active participation in professional development opportunities that are provided for Program Supervisors including Program Leadership Development (PLD) sessions.
- Participation in our in house mentoring program, Master Educator. This is an 18 month on going professional development, which encourages deeper thinking, collaboration and contains a research component.
